1. Portugal, 2. Belgium, 3. Netherlands, 4. Great Britain, 5. Austria, 6. France, 7. Switzerland, 8. Romania, 9. Spain, 10. USA, 11. Andorra, 12. Italy, 13. Germany, 14. Canada.

The remaining nations will start at the end of this order in the order of their preliminary entries.

6- Judges

International FITE judges are used for this event. Each Federation can provide at most one judge per obstacle for the ground jury. Each NETO can designate 2 to 4 judges, the Organising Committee will select 16 foreign judges.

The judges are invited by the Organising Committee on Friday evening to Sunday evening.

Travelling expenses for judges are not covered by the Organising Committee. Accommodation will be provided at Center Parcs.

Please note: No reimbursement when the accommodation is not used.

7- Rules and special participation conditions

The international TREC rules produced by the FITE in its latest edition and the national FFE rules are applied. All participants must agree to accept these rules when entering.

Riders participate in the Championship under their own responsibility. Any recourse against the organiser is impossible.

The veterinary inspection does not guarantee the health of horses.

People eligible to participate in the Championship:

- Seniors: For each nation, 6 qualified riders, aged a minimum of 16 years old; the organising country can enter an additional six individual riders.
- Young Riders: For each nation, 6 qualified riders, aged from 16 to 21 years old;
- Horses: must be aged a minimum of 6 years old; measuring at least 1m30 at the withers.

8- Rider insurance

Each rider is responsible for any damages that he or his horse may cause to themselves, to any third party or anything from the time of their arrival through to the time of leaving the event. It is therefore compulsory for each rider to be insured and for their insurance to cover their participation in competitions abroad.

9- Horse passports

The current general FEI rules shall apply. Any horse entered in events that take place in his country or abroad must have the official FEI passport, or a national passport approved by the FEI as an identification document and in order to determine the horse's ownership. All these horses must be correctly recorded and easily identifiable. Even if there are no national regulations in terms of vaccination against equine flu in the host nation and in the original nation, all horses must have a valid vaccination certificate.

10- Vaccinations

Vaccination against equine flu: FEI Veterinary Rule Appendix VII, current version. The "vaccination form" on an FEI passport or a national passport validated by the FEI or the National Federation, given to all horses and ponies, must include the stamp of a veterinary who is not the owner of the horse. This visa certifies that two injections have been administered to the horse with respect to its primary vaccination against equine flu within the space of at least 21 days and at most 92 days. In addition a follow-up injection must be administered during each successive 12 month period, from the second primary vaccination injection. Since the 1st January 1980, the interval between the follow-up vaccinations must not have exceeded 14 months. None of these injections must have been administered in the 7 days prior to the event including the day of the event, or the day of entering the competition stables. The above standards are the minimum essential requirement. Both for the primary vaccination and for the follow-up vaccinations it is recommended to follow manufacturer recommendations which correspond to rules stated by the FEI. In many cases follow-up vaccinations are recommended at intervals of less than 12 months.

11- Sanitary certificates

Each competitor must present the sanitary certificates required for transporting the horse to the competition when identifying the horses, in other words before entering the stables, whether this is:

- a) In the case of them coming from a EU member state - a sanitary certificate for registered equines according to appendix B or directive 90/426/CEE, currently in force,
- b) In the case of coming from another country - a sanitary certificate for registered equines according to appendix II of the Commission decision 92/260/CEE, currently in force.

A certificate must have been drawn up in the official language of the destination country and in an official language of the state of origin. Only an original certificate will be considered valid.

The organiser will check that all the necessary sanitary documents for the return transport have also been drawn up by the country of origin. This will be validated by the official competition vet before the teams start.

12- Horse inspection

Each rider must present his horse as well as the accompanying documents to the veterinary inspection that will take place on the competition site according to the programme on Friday morning, with the tack inspection taking place after this.

13- Anti-doping

Current FEI rules are applicable (Veterinary Rules Chap. V and VI, Appendix III).

Code of Conduct

The International Equestrian Tourism Federation (FITE) expect all people concerned by international equestrian sport to abide by the FEI Code of Conduct and for them to recognise and accept that the wellbeing of the horse is always considered above all else and that it will never be subject to any commercial or competitive influence.

1. The wellbeing of horses predominates over all other requirements at every stage of their preparation and training. This includes the correct management of horses, training methods, shoeing and tack as well as transport.
2. To be authorised to compete, horses and competitors must be physically capable, competent and in good health. This includes the use of drugs, surgical procedures which are a threat to the wellbeing or safety of horses, the gestation of mares or the incorrect use of aids.
3. Events must not be prejudicial to the wellbeing of horses. This implies constant attention to competitive areas, going, meteorological conditions, stabling, safety on the site and the aptitude of the horse to continue its travel after the event.
4. All efforts must be made in order to ensure that horses receive the attention that they merit after the competition and that they are treated humanely once their career is over. This covers the appropriate veterinary care, injuries during the competition, euthanasia and retirement.

The FEI strongly encourages all people concerned by equestrian sports to reach the highest level possible of knowledge in their respective areas of competency.

Presentation of team and accompanying person packages

➤ **The rider package includes:**

- Entry of the pair for the event (World Championship or European Championship),
- Accommodation for the horses in a stable with initial bedding. Hay and additional straw is sold at the event. Arrival from Wednesday afternoon or Monday according to the formula chosen.
- Accommodation of riders in Center Parc cottages booked for each team. (cf. brochure)
- Meals in the Equestrian Park restaurant (buffet, traditional cooking) from Thursday evening to Monday morning, whatever formula is chosen.
